- ACTIVE MAINLY AT NIGHT
- HIDES CLOSE TO WHERE PEOPLE SLEEP OR REST

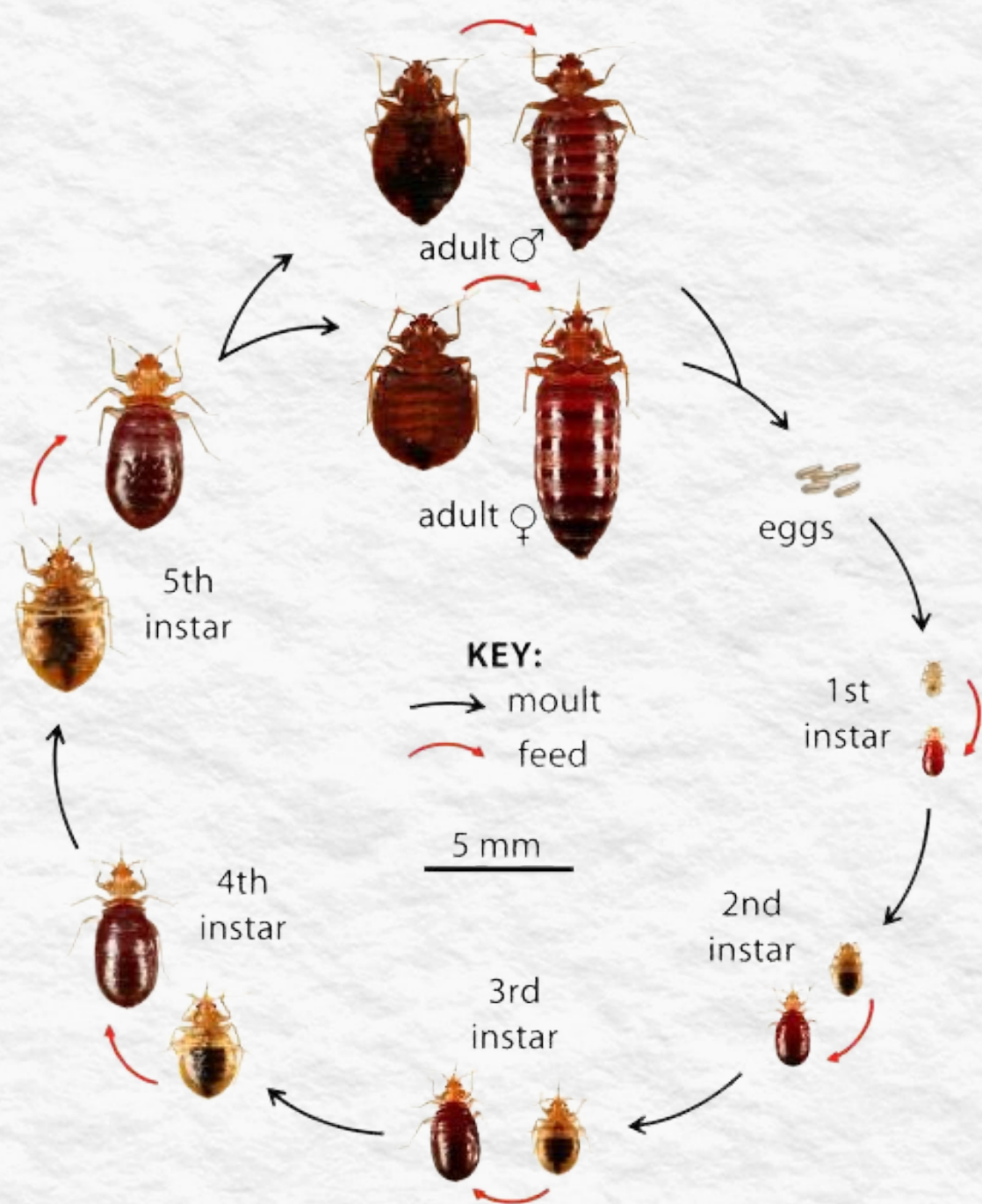


SIGNS OF INFESTATION

- BLOOD STAINS ON SHEETS
- SHED SKINS
- EGGS OR EGGSHELLS
- ITCHY BITES AFTER SLEEPING



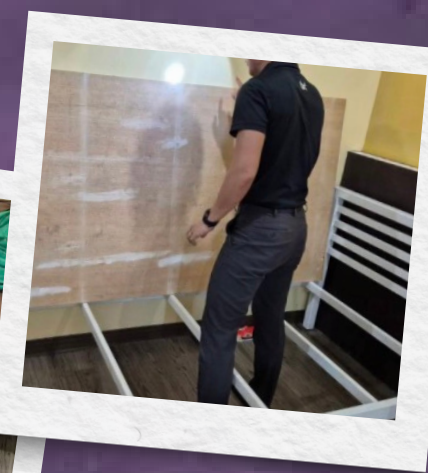
LIFE CYCLE OF BED BUGS
